Pinky is from Delhi's Sonia
Gandhi camp, a slum in
Kailash Nagar infamous for its
poor living conditions. She was
just three years old when her mother
died and subsequently abandoned by
her father.

The little girl was left in the lap of her elderly grandparents who despite facing extreme poverty raised her and sent her to school.

A bright student since her childhood, Pinky started excelling in her studies and aspired to complete her education and become a teacher.

A year-and-a-half ago, bad luck again struck when her grandfather, the sole income earner of the family passed away. The death left both her and ageing grandmother to fend for themselves, with little hope of Pinky completing her High School education.

It was at this point, Asha stepped into Pinky's life and provided the necessary counselling, guidance, motivation and resources to the family.

Now at 16, she has not only beat the odds by successfully appearing for her class 12 board exams last month but has also become a role model for other children in her community.

However, with the minuscule pension of her late grandfather, Pinky's further aspiration of attending college and becoming a teacher is a distant dream.

About 1700 Asha young people have received tertiary education through Asha's Higher Education Programme. This year, we are planning to increase the radius of education to every child living in the slum communities of Delhi.

Our Asha ambassadors and graduates are making every effort to reach out to penurious and bright students living in the slum communities so they can attend the Asha Centres to reap the benefits of higher education.
